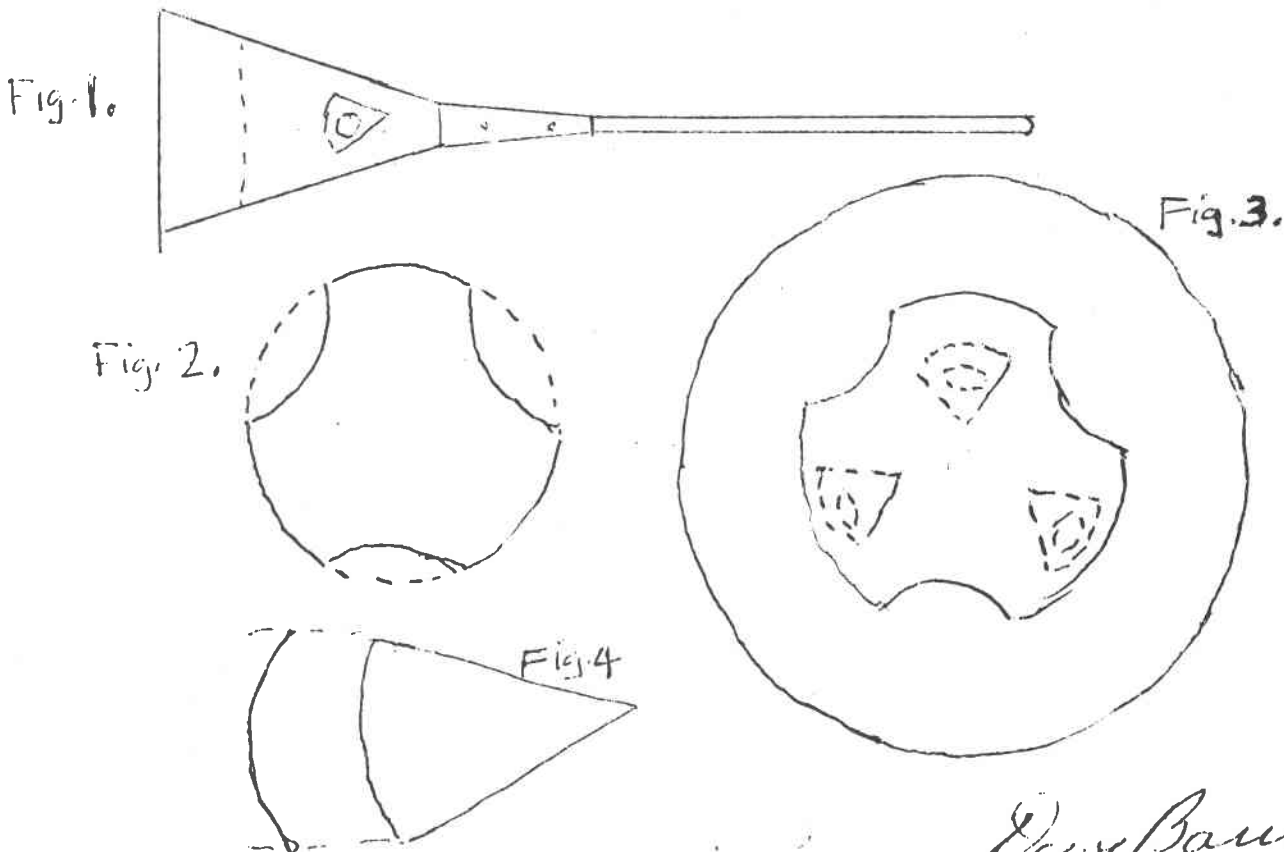
HAND OPERATED WASHINGMACHINE

PARTS

- 6" funnel
- 3/4" dowell to fit funnel spout.(round one end) } Fig (1)
- 2 small wood screws
- Top from tin oilcan . Cut as shown (2)
- Three tin triangles made from can top bent on a curve

Drill three holes in side of funnel. Solder triangles over holes. (3)
Solder can top inside funnel as in sketch. (4)
fasten dowell in spout. (Fig. 1)

To use, put rags to be washed in bucket with water and strong soap
plunge funnel up and down to force water through things to be washed.

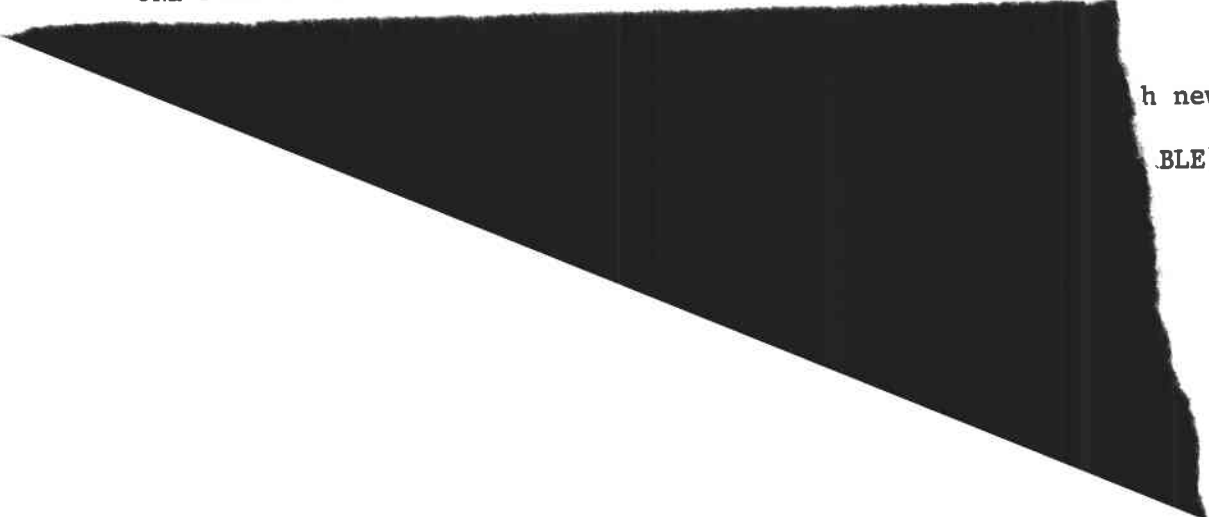

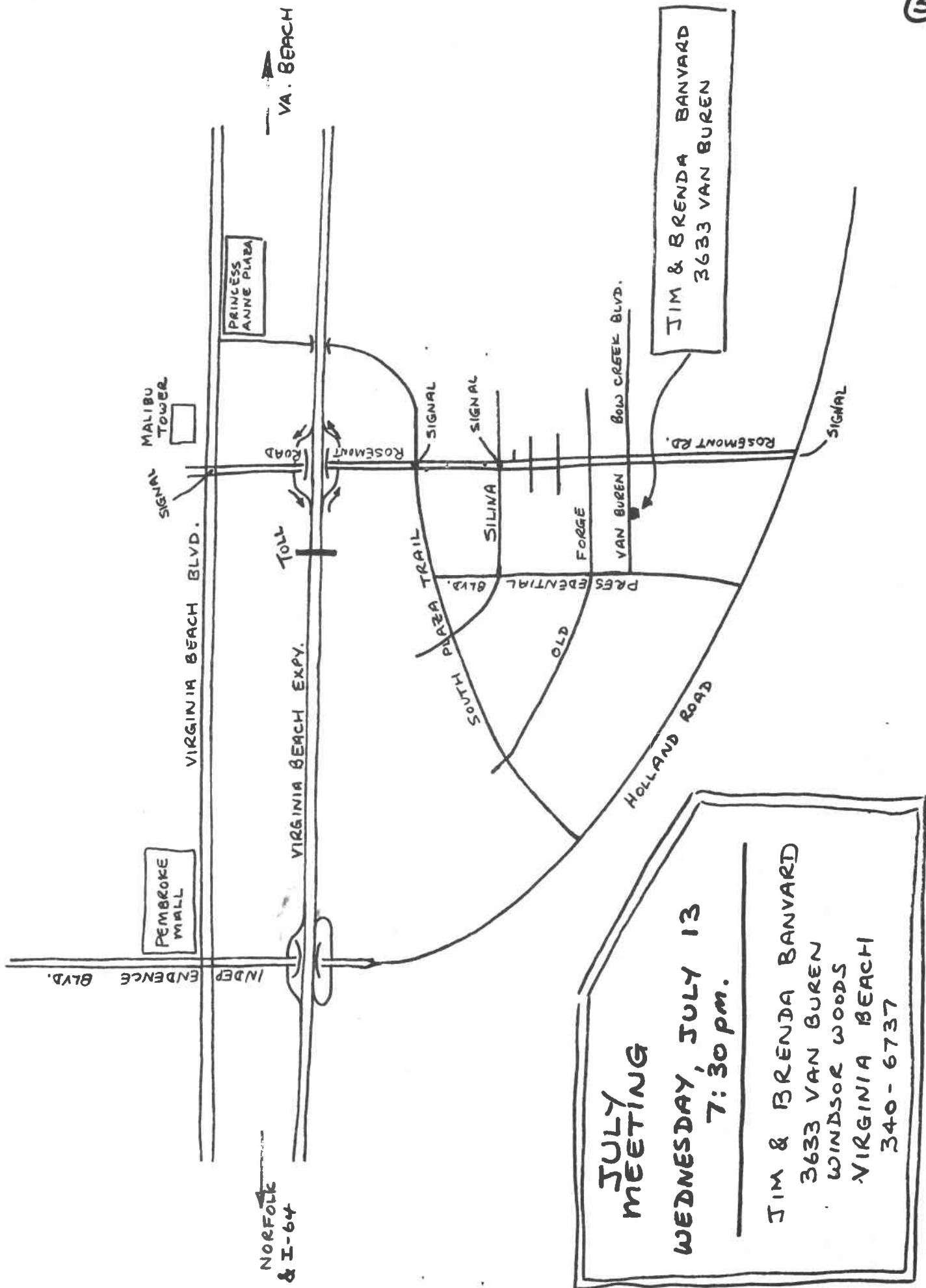

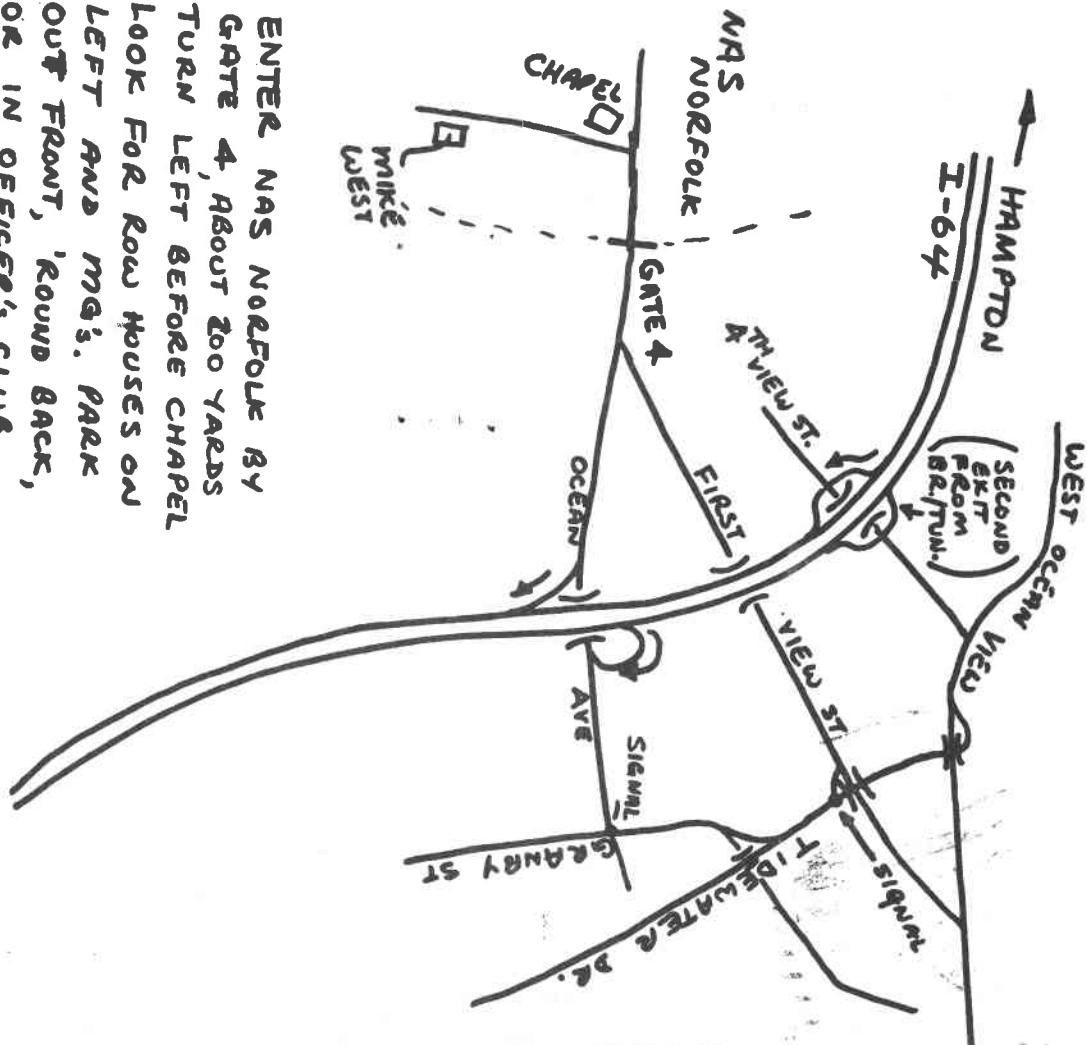
