IF THIS AMENDMENT TO THE BYLAWS DOES NOT PASS THOSE WHO PAID \$15.00 OR \$10.00 WILL HAVE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE OLD AND NEW DUES AMOUNT REFUNDED. The motion was made, seconded and voted upon with 1 vote against. Since no action could be made upon the above amendment until approved Fred McCall made the following motion. "We assess each member \$3.00 for in-town and \$2.00 for out of town membership starting July 1,1989 to be paid at the time of renewal of dues." This motion was seconded and voted upon with one 1 vote against. Mel Baker thanked everyone for their help on the progressive dinner. New Business - Butch says MG°s will park on his property and all others will park on the street at the next meeting. Marque Time - Fred McCall said he had Bart's Alinement on Witchduck Road fix his wire wheel problem. The job took 1.5 hours, cost \$40.00 and he is very satisfied. MEETING at Butch Bailback's home - 7:30 p.m. Due to lack of space on his property, Butch asks that <u>all non-MGs park on the street</u>.




